On June 12, 2008, the FIU Board of Trustees approved the closure of the Bachelor of Science in Exercise and Sports Sciences (Exercise Physiology Track) effective immediately.

**INTENDED MAJORS:**

If you have already taken a number of Exercise Physiology classes but you are still listed as **an intended major** because you have not completed one requirement (for example, GPA, Core, CLAST), you will need to complete the following in order to continue into the upper division of the Exercise Physiology program:

- Satisfy your missing Lower Division requirement(s) by December, 2008
- Apply for admission to Upper Division no later than January 12, 2009
- Complete degree requirements by the end of the Spring semester 2011
