

## **Bachelor of Spanish in Spanish Education Program Closure**

In Summer 2009, the FIU Board of Trustees approved the closure of the Bachelor of Spanish in Spanish Education effective fall 2009.

### **INTENDED MAJORS:**

If you have already taken a number of Spanish Education classes but you are still listed as **an intended major/pre-education** because you have not completed one requirement (for example, GPA, Core, CLAST), you will need to complete the following in order to continue into the upper division of the Spanish Education program:

Satisfy your missing Lower Division requirement(s) by December, 2009

Apply for admission to Upper Division no later than December, 2009

Complete degree requirements by the end of the Spring semester 2012
